CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicles – Operation When Approaching ~~Disabled~~ Stopped, Standing, or**
3 **Parked Vehicles**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a driver to make a certain lane change or to slow the speed
5 of the driver's vehicle in a certain manner when approaching from the rear a ~~disabled~~
6 stopped, standing, or parked vehicle displaying certain signals; and generally
7 relating to the rules of the road when approaching ~~disabled~~ stopped, standing, or
8 parked vehicles.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Transportation**

2 is:

3 (i) 1. On a highway; [and]

4 2. Using a visual signal that meets the requirements of §
5 22–218 or § 22–218.2 of this article; and

6 [(ii) 1.] **3. A.** A commercial motor vehicle providing emergency
7 maintenance to a disabled vehicle;

8 **[2.] B.** An emergency vehicle;

9 **[3.] C.** A service vehicle as defined under § 22–201 of this
10 article;

11 **[4.] D.** A tow truck that is properly registered in
12 accordance with § 13–920 of this article; or

13 **[5.] E.** A waste or recycling collection vehicle; **OR**

14 **(II) 1. ON A HIGHWAY; AND**

15 **2. ~~A DISABLED VEHICLE DISPLAYING~~ DISPLAYING:**

16 **A. HAZARD WARNING LIGHTS;**

17 **B. ROAD FLARES; OR**

18 **C. OTHER CAUTION SIGNALS, INCLUDING TRAFFIC**
19 **CONES, CAUTION SIGNS, OR NONVEHICULAR WARNING LIGHTS.**

20 (2) Unless otherwise directed by a police officer or a traffic control device,
21 the driver of a motor vehicle that approaches from the rear a stopped, standing, or parked
22 vehicle to which this subsection applies shall:

23 (i) If practicable and not otherwise prohibited and with due regard
24 for safety and traffic conditions, make a lane change into an available lane not immediately
25 adjacent to the stopped, standing, or parked vehicle; or

26 (ii) If the driver of the motor vehicle is unable to make a lane change
27 in accordance with item (i) of this paragraph, slow to a reasonable and prudent speed that
28 is safe for existing weather, road, and vehicular or pedestrian traffic conditions.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
30 October 1, 2022.
