BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Correctional Services** 15 16 3-906. The Commissioner shall: 17 (a) provide a suitable and efficient place, enclosed from public view, in 18 which an execution may be carried out; 19 20 (2)provide all of the materials that are necessary to perform the 21execution: and 22 subject to subsection (c) of this section, select the individuals to 23perform the execution.

1	(b)	The Commissioner	or	the	Commissioner's	designee	shall	supervise	the
2	execution.								

- 3 (c) (1) An execution shall be performed by individuals who are selected by 4 the Commissioner and trained to administer the lethal injection.
- 5 (2) An individual who administers the paralytic agent and lethal 6 injection need not be licensed or certified as any type of health care practitioner under 7 the Health Occupations Article.
- 8 (D) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE INTERPRETED TO REQUIRE A
 9 PHYSICIAN, NURSE, PHARMACIST, OR EMPLOYEE OF THE DIVISION OR ANY
 10 OTHER PERSON TO BE IN ATTENDANCE AT OR PARTICIPATE IN ANY ASPECT OF
 11 AN EXECUTION WHICH IS CONTRARY TO THE MORAL OR RELIGIOUS BELIEFS OF
 12 THE PERSON.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
