14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 **3–709.**

18 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT THREATEN, ASSAULT, OR WOUND AN OFFICER 19 ATTEMPTING THE LAWFUL SERVICE OF CIVIL PROCESS WITH THE INTENTION OF 20 OBSTRUCTING THE SERVICE OR OTHERWISE KNOWINGLY OR INTENTIONALLY 21 INTERFERE WITH THE SERVICE.

22(B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A23MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT24EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
