# Calvert County - County Superintendent of Schools - Postemployment Compensation and Benefits

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Education

18 4–202.

19 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each county 20 superintendent is entitled to the compensation set by the county board.

- 21 (2) In Prince George's County, the Chief Executive Officer is entitled to the 22 compensation set by the contract with the county board.
- (b) (1) The salary of a county superintendent may not be decreased during the
   superintendent's term of office.

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(2)Each county superintendent shall devote full time to public school 1  $\mathbf{2}$ business.

3 (c) In Anne Arundel County, the county board may not pay monetary compensation to the county superintendent for sick leave benefits earned while employed 4 by any other board of education or public school system but may allow the county  $\mathbf{5}$ superintendent to use the sick leave in the same manner as sick leave accrued while 6 7employed by the county.

8 IN CALVERT COUNTY, ANY POSTEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION AND **(D)** 9 BENEFITS PROVIDED TO THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT SHALL BE COMMENSURATE 10 WITH THE POSTEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS PROVIDED TO 11 PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL IN THE COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM WHO HAVE THE SAME 12**TENURE AND VESTED BENEFITS.** 

13SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 14of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the County Superintendent of Calvert County while serving in a term 15of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act 16 17concerning the salary or compensation of the County Superintendent of Calvert County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does 18 19not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out 20an unexpired term.

21SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 221, 2018.
