1 AN ACT concerning

Video Lottery Facility - Areas Prohibited to Individuals Under the Age of 21 Years - Employee Exception

FOR the purpose of altering a prohibition on certain individuals entering and remaining in
an area within a video lottery facility designated for table game or video lottery
terminal activities to allow an adult who is a video lottery employee to work in the
area; and generally relating to a prohibition on certain individuals entering or
remaining in an area within a video lottery facility designated for certain activities.

15 (2) A VIDEO LOTTERY EMPLOYEE WHO IS AN ADULT MAY ENTER OR 16 REMAIN IN AN AREA WITHIN A VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY THAT IS DESIGNATED FOR 17 TABLE GAME OR VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINAL ACTIVITIES IF THE VIDEO LOTTERY 18 EMPLOYEE IS WORKING.

(c) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A video lottery operation licensee shall ensure that intoxicated individuals and individuals under the age of 21 years are not allowed to play video lottery terminals or table games and are not allowed in areas of the video lottery facility where video lottery terminals or table games are located.

(2) A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE MAY ALLOW A VIDEO
 LOTTERY EMPLOYEE WHO IS AN ADULT TO ENTER OR REMAIN IN AN AREA WITHIN
 THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY THAT IS DESIGNATED FOR TABLE GAME OR VIDEO
 LOTTERY TERMINAL ACTIVITIES IF THE VIDEO LOTTERY EMPLOYEE IS WORKING.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2015.
