- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 18 Article - Tax - Property

- 19 14-811.
- 20 (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (e) of this section, the collector may
- 21 withhold from sale any property, when the total taxes on the property, including interest
- 22 and penalties, amount to less than \$250 in any 1 year.
- 23 (b) (1) The collector may withhold from sale any residential property, when
- 24 the total taxes on the property, including interest and penalties, amount to less than \$750.



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- 1 (2) In Baltimore City, the collector shall withhold from sale 2 owner-occupied residential property, when the total taxes on the property, including 3 interest and penalties, amount to less than [\$750] \$2,500.
  - (3) In Baltimore City, the collector shall withhold from sale residential property or property that is exempt from taxation under § 7–204(1) or (2) of this article, if the taxes on the property consist only of a lien for unpaid charges for water and sewer service.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9  $\,$  1, 2021.
