1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Dealers – Licensing and Temporary Registration Plates**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of vehicles that a person may sell during a
4 certain time period before being included under the defined term “dealer” as the
5 term applies to certain provisions of the vehicle law; repealing a certain
6 provision of law that requires a motor vehicle dealer that issues temporary
7 registration plates to apply for at least a certain number of the temporary
8 registration plates; and generally relating to vehicle dealers.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Transportation**

1 “Dealer” means a person who is in the business of buying, selling, or exchanging
2 vehicles including a person who during any 12-month period offers to sell [five]
3 **THREE** or more vehicles, the ownership of which was acquired for resale purposes.

4 13-601.

5 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Administration
6 may design temporary registration plates and furnish them to any licensed dealer
7 who:

8 (1) [On] **APPLIES ON** the form that the Administration requires[,
9 applies for at least five of these plates]; and

10 (2) With the application, submits a fee established by the
11 Administration for each plate.

12 (b) A wholesale dealer may not apply for temporary registration plates.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2011.
