17 18	(a) (1) Each nonstudent member of the county board is entitled to receive [\$7,500] \$12,500 annually as compensation.
19 20	(2) A student member who completes a full term on the county board shall be granted a scholarship of [\$1,000] \$1,500 to be applied toward the student's higher

a member is entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided for in the

education costs.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the nonstudent members or the scholarship amount for the student member of the Baltimore County Board of Education while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the nonstudent members or the scholarship amount for the student member of the Baltimore County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
