- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Correctional Services

- (a) (1) [The] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE
- 16 Commissioner and Chief Executive Officer shall establish the compensation rate for inmate
- 17 labor in Maryland Correctional Enterprises, taking into consideration other wage
- 18 payments and incentives in other programs.
- 19 (2) The compensation rate for inmate labor in Maryland
- 20 CORRECTIONAL ENTERPRISES MAY NOT BE LESS THAN THE STATE MINIMUM WAGE

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- (b) After review by the Management Council, and after consideration of any recommendation by the Chief Executive Officer, the Commissioner shall adopt regulations in accordance with Title 10, Subtitle 1 of the State Government Article that govern the method and time of compensation payments.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2019.
