- 25 (2) (3) In addition to the newspaper notice required under § 4–208 of
- 26 this article AND PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, OR THE ONLINE NOTICE
- 27 AUTHORIZED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, the Board shall post a
- 28 suitable notice in a conspicuous place at the location described in the application for at least
- 29 10 days before holding a hearing on the application.

A notice under this section shall state the class of license for which application
