1 AN ACT concerning

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Algorithmic Decision Systems - Procurement and Discriminatory Acts

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a State unit to purchase a product or service that is or 4 contains an algorithmic decision system that adheres to responsible artificial 5 intelligence standards; specifying content included in responsible artificial 6 intelligence standards; requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt certain 7 regulations; altering the definition of "discriminatory act" used in certain provisions 8 of human relations law to include acts performed through algorithmic decision 9 systems; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the use of algorithmic decision systems. 10

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- 1 (f) "Protective hairstyle" includes braids, twists, and locks.
- 2 (g) "Race" includes traits associated with race, including hair texture, afro 3 hairstyles, and protective hairstyles.
- 4 (h) (1) "Respondent" means a person accused in a complaint of a 5 discriminatory act.
- 6 (2) "Respondent" includes a person identified during an investigation of a complaint and joined as an additional or substitute respondent.
- 8 (i) "Sexual orientation" means the identification of an individual as to male or 9 female homosexuality, heterosexuality, or bisexuality.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2021.
