- 3 (A) This section does not apply to restaurant services provided 4 At a drive-through window.
- 5 (B) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020, A RESTAURANT MAY NOT PROVIDE A 6 SINGLE-USE PLASTIC STRAW TO A CUSTOMER DINING IN AT THE RESTAURANT 7 UNLESS THE CUSTOMER REQUESTS A STRAW.
- 8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2019.
