- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 18 (A) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL KEEP A RECORD OF THE RACE AND
- GENDER OF: 19
- 20 **(1)** ALL APPLICANTS FOR A POSITION WITH THE LOCAL SCHOOL
- 21SYSTEM; AND
- 22 **(2)** ANY INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE HIRED FOR A POSITION WITH THE
- 23 LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM.



- 1 (B) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL COMPILE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED 2 UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IN A SEARCHABLE AND ANALYZABLE 3 ELECTRONIC FORMAT.
- 4 (C) ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2022, EACH 5 COUNTY BOARD SHALL PUBLISH ON ITS WEBSITE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED 6 UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION FOR THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 7 CALENDAR YEAR.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2020.
