20	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 5 (A) THE TRUST SHALL DEVELOP A PROCESS FOR THE WAIVER, IN
- 6 EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES, OF REQUIREMENTS, REGULATIONS, AND
- 7 PROCESSES APPLICABLE TO A PROPERTY SUBJECT TO A HISTORIC PRESERVATION

- 11 (1) THE PROPERTY IS SUBJECT TO REPEATED FLOODING OR OTHER
- 12 CONTINUING CONDITIONS THAT HAVE RESULTED IN DAMAGE TO THE PROPERTY'S
- 13 INFRASTRUCTURE;
- 14 (2) THERE IS AN URGENT NEED TO STABILIZE HISTORIC STRUCTURES
- 15 OR CONDUCT ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION AT THE PROPERTY;
- 16 (3) THE COST OF COMPLYING WITH THE REQUIREMENTS,
- 17 REGULATIONS, OR PROCESSES OF THE TRUST WOULD EXCEED THE NORMAL COST
- 18 OF AN UNDERTAKING BY 20% OR MORE;
- 19 (4) EXTRAORDINARY INFRASTRUCTURE COSTS CHALLENGE THE
- 20 VIABILITY OF AN UNDERTAKING; OR
- 21 (5) THE TRUST DETERMINES THAT, IN THE ABSENCE OF A WAIVER,
- 22 THE PROPERTY MAY BECOME ABANDONED OR DILAPIDATED.
