13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17	(A) THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS SHALL:
18	(1) ESTABLISH A SPECIAL COURT DOCKET IN EACH OF THE CIRCUIT
19	COURTS TO EXCLUSIVELY HEAR AND DECIDE CASES ALLEGING:
20	(I) A VIOLATION UNDER TITLE 4 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW
21	ARTICLE; OR



- 1 (II) A VIOLATION UNDER TITLE 3 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW 2 ARTICLE USING A DANGEROUS WEAPON; AND
- 3 (2) ASSIGN PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE 4 REQUIREMENTS OF ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 5 (B) A COURT ASSIGNED A CASE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 6 SHALL FOLLOW THE RULES OF PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE APPLICABLE TO THAT 7 COURT.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2022.
