A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Public Health – Asthma Hot Spot Elimination Grant Program

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Asthma Hot Spot Elimination Grant Program; providing for the purpose of the Program; requiring the Maryland Department of 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Health to administer the Program; requiring an applicant to submit a certain 6 application to the Department to qualify for a grant under the Program; requiring 7 the Department to award grants on a certain basis and prioritize awarding grants 8 on a certain basis; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining a 9 certain term; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Asthma Hot Spot Elimination Grant Program. 10

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ASTHMA HOT SPOT" MEANS AN AREA WITH A 23 POPULATION THAT SUFFERS FROM HIGHER THAN AVERAGE RATES OF ASTHMA AND 24 ASTHMA–RELATED ILLNESSES.

1 (B) THERE IS AN ASTHMA HOT SPOT ELIMINATION GRANT PROGRAM IN 2 THE DEPARTMENT.

3 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO AWARD GRANTS TO 4 ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, HOSPITALS, AND 5 HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT PROGRAMS AIMED AT 6 REDUCING OR ELIMINATING ASTHMA HOT SPOTS AND REDUCING THE USE OF 7 EMERGENCY DEPARTMENTS IN ASTHMA HOT SPOTS.

8 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.

9 (E) TO QUALIFY FOR A GRANT UNDER THE PROGRAM, AN APPLICANT MUST 10 SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR DEVELOPING AND 11 IMPLEMENTING A PROGRAM THAT:

12 (1) AIMS TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE ASTHMA HOT SPOTS ON A LOCAL 13 OR STATEWIDE BASIS;

14 (2) AIMS TO REDUCE THE NUMBER AND FREQUENCY OF EMERGENCY
 15 DEPARTMENT VISITS FOR ASTHMA OR ASTHMA–RELATED ILLNESSES IN ASTHMA
 16 HOT SPOTS; AND

17(3) INCLUDES A PROCESS FOR MEASURING OUTCOMES OF THE18PROGRAM.

- 19 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 20 (1) AWARD GRANTS ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS; AND

21 (2) PRIORITIZE AWARDING GRANTS TO PROGRAMS BASED ON 22 MEASURABLE OUTCOMES.

23 (G) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 24 SECTION.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2018. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of September 27 30, 2023, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be 28 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
