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## Procurement – <del>Maryland Buy American Steel and</del> <u>Purchase of American</u> Manufactured Goods <del>Act</del>

FOR the purpose of altering the Maryland Buy American Steel Act to include 4 5 American manufactured goods; requiring a public body to require that certain 6 contractors and subcontractors use or supply only American manufactured 7 goods under certain procurements; defining a term; providing for the application 8 of this Act; requiring a public body to give a certain notice; requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt certain regulations regarding the granting of a 9 preference for the use of American manufactured goods; and generally relating 10 to the Maryland Buy American Steel and Manufactured Goods Act State 11 procurement law to grant a preference for American manufactured goods in 12 13 State contracting; requiring a public body to require that certain contractors 14 and subcontractors use or supply American manufactured goods under certain procurements; providing for the application and construction of this Act; 15 requiring a public body to give a certain notice; requiring the Board of Public 16 Works to adopt certain regulations regarding the granting of a preference for 17 the use of American manufactured goods; defining certain terms; and generally 18 19 relating to the purchase of American manufactured goods.
