2 **Grand Prix Motor Racing – Designation**

3 FOR the purpose of designating Grand Prix motor racing as the State motor vehicle
4 speed competition.

10 Preamble

11 WHEREAS, Grand Prix motor racing involves a speed competition of
12 open–wheel, technologically advanced racecars on closed highways or other courses
13 simulating road conditions; and

14 WHEREAS, Many open–wheel racecars are capable of speeds exceeding 220
15 miles per hour; and

16 WHEREAS, Baltimore will be hosting the inaugural Baltimore Grand Prix from
17 September 2, 2011, through September 4, 2011; and

18 WHEREAS, The Baltimore Grand Prix will feature 3 days of world–class motor
19 racing and will culminate in an IZOD IndyCar Series race; and

20 WHEREAS, The IZOD IndyCar Series is the premier open–wheel racing series
21 in North America; and
