12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), (4), and (6) of this 17 subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays.
