- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16	A PERSON	MAY NOT USE CHLORPYRIFOS IN THE STATE, INCLUDING:
17	(1)	INSECTICIDES THAT CONTAIN CHLORPYRIFOS; AND
18	(2)	SEEDS THAT HAVE BEEN TREATED WITH CHLORPYRIFOS.



1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of 2 Agriculture shall, with existing budgeted resources, provide to farmers, certified crop 3 advisors, and pesticide applicators education and assistance relating to integrated pest 4 management, including information on safer alternatives to chlorpyrifos.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2020.
