1 AN ACT concerning

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Public Safety – Department of State Police – Yellow Dot Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Yellow Dot Program in the Department of State Police in order to provide a means to alert emergency responders to 4 $\mathbf{5}$ health-related information in the event a Program participant is involved in a 6 vehicle emergency and is unable to communicate; providing that a Program 7participant, by affixing a yellow dot decal to a vehicle, consents to a certain 8 search of the vehicle's glove compartment or glove box by emergency responders 9 under certain circumstances; requiring the Department to design and make available certain materials necessary to implement and administer the 10 Program; requiring the Department to publicize the Program and distribute 11 12Program materials in cooperation with the Motor Vehicle Administration; and 13 generally relating to the Yellow Dot Program.

10 (B) IN COOPERATION WITH THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION, 11 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLICIZE THE PROGRAM AND DISTRIBUTE 12 PROGRAM MATERIALS.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect14 October 1, 2012.
