13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (b) Promptly after an inmate is sentenced to the jurisdiction of the Division, the 20 Division shall assemble an adequate case record for the inmate that includes:

- 4 (e) In accordance with regulations adopted by the Division, the managing official 5 of each correctional facility shall maintain, as a part of an inmate's case record:
- 6 (1) an adequate record of the conduct, effort, and progress of the inmate 7 during confinement; and
- 8 (2) a record of the character of any offense committed by the inmate and 9 the nature and amount of punishment inflicted.
- 10 (f) To identify an inmate, the Division may photograph and fingerprint the 11 inmate and record a description of the inmate's personal background data.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2018.
