14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES" INCLUDES:
19	(1) ILLNESS;
20	(2) Injury;
21	(3) HOSPITALIZATION; AND

- 2 (B) CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS AND CENTERS SHALL AUTHORIZE 3 STUDENTS TO WITHDRAW FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.
- 4 (C) IF A STUDENT WITHDRAWS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES, THE 5 CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OR CENTER SHALL REIMBURSE THE STUDENT ANY 6 TUITION AND FEES PAID BY THE STUDENT FOR THE SEMESTER DURING WHICH THE 7 STUDENT WITHDRAWS.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2023.
