2	State Retirement and Pension System - Vesting and Eligibility

- FOR the purpose of altering the eligibility requirements that certain members of the State Retirement and Pension System must meet in order to qualify for certain benefits; altering the number of years of service certain members of the State Retirement and Pension System must accrue to vest in certain retirement and pension systems of the State Retirement and Pension System; and generally relating to members of the State Retirement and Pension System vesting in the several systems of the State Retirement and Pension Systems.

- 1 (a) (1) This subsection applies to a member who joins the 2 Employees' Pension System or Teachers' Pension System on or 3 Before June 30, 2011.
- 4 (2) A member may retire with a normal service retirement allowance 5 if:
- 6 **[**(1)**] (I)** the member completes and submits a written application to the Board of Trustees stating the date when the member desires to retire; and
- 8 [(2)] (II) on or before the date of retirement, the member:
- 9 [(i)] 1. has at least 30 years of eligibility service;
- [(ii)] 2. has a combined total of at least 30 years of eligibility service from the Employees' Pension System, the Teachers' Pension System, the Employees' Retirement System, or the Teachers' Retirement System; or
- 13 [(iii)] **3.** has attained the age and the years of eligibility 14 service as follows:
