2 Marine Contractor License – Performance of Services – Licensing Requirements 3 and Fees

- 4 FOR the purpose of altering the circumstances under which an individual who is employed 5 by an agency of the State is authorized to perform marine contractor services without 6 having to obtain a marine contractor license; authorizing an individual who is 7 employed by a county or municipality in the State to perform marine contractor 8 services while in the performance of the duties of their employment without having 9 to obtain a marine contractor license under certain circumstances; exempting certain 10 individuals who perform marine contractor services while in the performance of the 11 duties of their employment from paying certain fees; and generally relating to marine contractor licenses and fees. 12

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
