1 AN ACT concerning

School Bus Monitoring Cameras – Civil Penalty – Sunset Repeal

for failure to stop for a school vehicle operating alternately flashing red lights; and

HOUSE BILL 343

1 (a) If a school vehicle has stopped on a roadway and is operating the alternately 2 flashing red lights specified in § 22–228 of this article, the driver of any other vehicle 3 meeting or overtaking the school vehicle shall stop at least 20 feet from the rear of the 4 school vehicle, if approaching the school vehicle from its rear, or at least 20 feet from the 5 front of the school vehicle, if approaching the school vehicle from its front.

6 (b) If a school vehicle has stopped on a roadway and is operating the alternately 7 flashing red lights specified in § 22–228 of this article, the driver of any other vehicle 8 meeting or overtaking the school vehicle may not proceed until the school vehicle resumes 9 motion or the alternately flashing red lights are deactivated.

10 (c) This section does not apply to the driver of a vehicle on a divided highway, if 11 the school vehicle is on a different roadway.

12 (d) A person convicted of a violation of this section is subject to a fine not 13 exceeding \$1,000.

- 15 (a) (6) "Violation" means a violation of § 21–706 of this subtitle.

16 (e) (1) Unless the driver of the motor vehicle received a citation from a police 17 officer at the time of the violation, the owner or, in accordance with subsection (h)(5) of this 18 section, the driver of a motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty if the motor vehicle is 19 recorded by a school bus monitoring camera during the commission of a violation.

- (2) A civil penalty under this subsection may not exceed \$500.

(3) For purposes of this section, the District Court shall prescribe:

(i) A uniform citation form consistent with subsection (f)(1) of this
 section and § 7–302 of the Courts Article; and

- (ii) A civil penalty, which shall be indicated on the citation, to be paid
 by persons who choose to prepay the civil penalty without appearing in District Court.
