16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

2 (28) The nonprofit corporation serving as the local public transportation
3 authority for Garrett County pursuant to a contract or memorandum of understanding with
4 Garrett County (Garrett County Community Action Committee, Inc.); [and]

5 (29) The nonprofit corporation serving as the industrial development
6 authority of Carroll County established under Title 12, Subtitle 1 of the Economic
7 Development Article; AND

8 (30) THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES POOLED OPEB
9 TRUST FUND.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2021.
