- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain organizations to hold certain casino events in 5 Howard County at certain intervals of time; requiring an organization to obtain a 6 permit from the Howard County Department of Inspections, Licenses, and Permits 7 before operating a casino event; requiring the Howard County Executive to forward 8 a recommendation to the Howard County Council concerning the fee to be charged 9 for a permit; requiring the County Council to adopt by resolution the amount of the 10 permit fee; specifying the types of organizations eligible to conduct a casino event; 11 requiring a permit holder for a casino event to ensure that certain standards are met; 12 prohibiting a permit holder from offering cumulative prizes in excess of a certain 13 amount; specifying certain prohibited acts and reporting requirements for a permit 14 holder for a casino event; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations 15 governing casino events; altering in Howard County the application of certain general provisions of law governing gaming in the State; establishing certain 16 17 exceptions to prohibitions against conducting a casino event or operating or 18 awarding prizes using certain gaming devices; defining a certain term; and generally 19 relating to casino events in Howard County.



- 2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 3 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 4 Article Criminal Law
- 5 13–1601.
- 6 (a) This subtitle applies only in Howard County.
- 7 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, Subtitle 2 of this 8 title applies in Howard County.
- 9 (2) Subtitle 2 of this title does not apply to bingo regulated under §
- 10 13–1602 of this subtitle OR A CASINO EVENT REGULATED UNDER § 13–1602.1 OF THIS
- 11 SUBTITLE.
- 12 **13–1602.1.**
- 13 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE HOWARD COUNTY
- 14 DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTIONS, LICENSES, AND PERMITS.
- 15 (B) (1) BEFORE AN ORGANIZATION LISTED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS
- 16 SECTION MAY OPERATE A CASINO EVENT, THE ORGANIZATION SHALL OBTAIN A
- 17 PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
- 18 (2) (I) ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE DEPARTMENT, THE
- 19 COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL FORWARD TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL A
- 20 RECOMMENDATION FOR THE FEE TO BE CHARGED FOR A PERMIT UNDER THIS
- 21 SECTION.
- 22 (II) THE COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL ADOPT BY RESOLUTION THE
- 23 AMOUNT OF THE PERMIT FEE.
- 24 (C) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (D) AND (E) OF THIS SECTION, AN
- 25 ORGANIZATION MAY CONDUCT:
- 26 (1) ONE CASINO EVENT THAT INCLUDES A CARD GAME DURING EACH
- 27 CALENDAR MONTH; AND
- 28 (2) ONE CASINO EVENT THAT INCLUDES ROULETTE DURING EACH
- 29 CALENDAR YEAR.

- 1 (D) TO CONDUCT A CASINO EVENT UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 2 SECTION, AN ORGANIZATION SHALL BE:
- 3 (1) A BONA FIDE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY; OR
- 4 (2) A BONA FIDE WAR VETERANS' ORGANIZATION.
- 5 (E) (1) A PERMIT HOLDER FOR A CASINO EVENT THAT INCLUDES A CARD 6 GAME OR ROULETTE SHALL ENSURE THAT:
- 7 (I) AN INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS DOES NOT 8 BENEFIT FINANCIALLY FROM THE HOLDING OF THE CASINO EVENT;
- 9 (II) AN INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS DOES NOT 10 RECEIVE ANY OF THE PROCEEDS OF THE CASINO EVENT FOR PERSONAL USE OR 11 BENEFIT;
- 12 (III) THE CASINO EVENT IS MANAGED PERSONALLY BY THE 13 MEMBERS OF THE PERMIT HOLDER;
- 14 (IV) A PARENT, A SUBSIDIARY, OR AN AFFILIATE OF THE 15 ORGANIZATION SPONSORING THE EVENT HAS NOT SPONSORED A CASINO EVENT 16 WITHIN THE CALENDAR MONTH OR CALENDAR YEAR, AS APPROPRIATE; AND
- 17 (V) THE CASINO EVENT IS CONDUCTED BETWEEN 4 P.M. AND 1 18 A.M.
- 19 **(2)** A PERSON THAT HOLDS A CASINO EVENT THAT INCLUDES A CARD 20 GAME OR ROULETTE MAY NOT:
- 21 (I) OFFER OR AWARD CUMULATIVE PRIZES THAT HAVE A FAIR 22 MARKET VALUE IN EXCESS OF \$5,000 AT THE EVENT;
- 23 (II) ALLOW A PLAYER TO BET MORE THAN \$10 IN TOKENS IN ANY 24 ONE GAME WITHIN THE CALENDAR MONTH OR CALENDAR YEAR, AS APPROPRIATE;
- 25 (III) EXCHANGE TOKENS USED IN WAGERING FOR AN ITEM OF 26 MERCHANDISE THAT IS WORTH MORE THAN \$1,000; OR
- 27 (IV) EXCHANGE MERCHANDISE THAT WAS RECEIVED FOR 28 TOKENS THAT WERE USED IN WAGERING FOR AN ITEM OF MERCHANDISE HAVING A
- 29 VALUE THAT IS DIFFERENT FROM THE FAIR RETAIL MARKET VALUE OF THE ITEM OF
- 30 MERCHANDISE THAT WAS RECEIVED FOR THE TOKENS.



1	Notwithstanding Subtitle 2 of this title AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN §
2	13-1602.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, a person may not conduct a casino night or operate any of
3	the following gaming devices:

- 4 (1) a card game;
- 5 (2) a dice game; or
- 6 (3) roulette.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2015.
