## Community Colleges - Students With Disabilities

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission to consult with the Maryland Association of Community Colleges when establishing a certain review 4 5 process and adopting certain guidelines or regulations for a grant program for 6 supplemental services and supports for students with disabilities; requiring, 7 beginning in a certain fiscal year, that the Governor include in the annual budget 8 bill at least a certain appropriation to the Commission to be used to award grants for 9 a certain program; and generally relating to the grant program for supplemental services and supports for students with disabilities in community colleges. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

#### 18 Article – Education

- 20 (a) The Commission shall establish and administer a grant program for 21 supplemental services and supports for students with disabilities in community colleges.
- 22 (b) The Commission, in cooperation with the Department of Disabilities AND IN 23 CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES, 24 shall:

### **HOUSE BILL 475**

- 1 (1) Establish a competitive review process for the awarding of grants to 2 community colleges; and
- 3 (2) Adopt any other guidelines or regulations necessary for the 4 administration of this section.
- 5 (C) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION OF AT LEAST \$2,500,000 TO THE COMMISSION TO BE USED TO AWARD GRANTS UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2020.
