- 23 AN OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEM MAY NOT ACCEPT:



- 1 (1) TRUCKLOADS OF SEPARATELY COLLECTED YARD WASTE FOR
- 2 FINAL DISPOSAL UNLESS THE OWNER OR OPERATOR PROVIDES FOR THE
- 3 COMPOSTING OR MULCHING OF THE YARD WASTE; OR
- 4 (2) LOADS OF SEPARATELY COLLECTED FOOD WASTE FOR FINAL
- 5 DISPOSAL UNLESS THE OWNER OR OPERATOR PROVIDES FOR THE COMPOSTING OF
- 6 THE FOOD WASTE.

- 8 (A) ALL YARD WASTE COLLECTED SEPARATELY FROM OTHER SOLID WASTE
- 9 MAY BE TRANSPORTED TO A COMPOSTING FACILITY.
- 10 (B) THE COMPOSTING FACILITY MAY BE LOCATED AT A REFUSE DISPOSAL
- 11 SYSTEM.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
