FOR the purpose of requiring the holder of a certain special multiple event license in 4 Garrett County that a certain organization for which a special multiple event Class 5 6 <del>C license is issued</del> to ensure that at least one individual who is certified by an 7 approved alcohol awareness program is on the premises when alcoholic beverages may be sold are served; authorizing a the license holder of a special multiple event 8 9 Class C license to store certain alcoholic beverages between certain events under 10 certain circumstances and conditions; requiring the license holder to keep certain 11 records in a certain manner; authorizing certain personnel of the Comptroller's 12 Office and the Board of License Commissioners of Garrett County to inspect certain 13 records in a certain manner; providing that a license holder who violates this Act is subject to certain fines and denial of certain licenses; making a technical change; and 14 15 generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Garrett County.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 2 7-101.3 (g) (1)In Garrett County, there are 4 types of special Class C beer, beer and wine, or beer, wine and liquor licenses available, as follows: 4 A special 2-day Class C license for a fee of \$50; 5 (i) 6 A special 6-day Class C license for a fee of \$150; (ii) 7 (iii) A special 12-day Class C license for a fee of \$300; or 8 (iv) A special multiple event Class C license under the following 9 conditions: 10 1. The Board of License Commissioners may issue a special 11 multiple event license to an organization that otherwise qualifies for a special Class C 12 license: 2. The annual fee for a special multiple event license is as 13 follows: 14 15 Α. \$125 for up to 5 events per year; B. 16 \$250 for up to 12 events per year; C. 17 \$375 for up to 18 events per year; and 18 D. \$500 for up to 24 events per year; 19 The Board may not issue more than 1 special multiple 3. 20 event license to an organization in a license year; 21 A special multiple event licensee shall notify the Board in 22writing at least 7 days before an event; and 23The Board shall publish a notice for application for a 5. special multiple event license one time at least 7 days before the hearing on the license. 24 25(2)Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the Garrett 26County Board of License Commissioners may grant a license holder a privilege at no charge 27 to sell for consumption off the licensed premises an alcoholic beverage authorized by the 28license if:
- The alcoholic beverage is bottled in commemorative or special event bottles and sold at a special event;

3 4	3. The alcoholic beverage will be sold at the event only on the days and hours allowed by the Board.

7	1. Special 2-day Class C license;
8	2. Special 6-day Class C license;
9	3. Special 12–day Class C license; or
0	4. Special [multi-event] MULTIPLE EVENT Class C license.
12 13 14 15 16	CLASS C LICENSE IS ISSUED SHALL ENSURE THAT AT LEAST ONE SERVER WHO IS CERTIFIED BY AN APPROVED ALCOHOL AWARENESS PROGRAM IS ON THE PREMISES WHEN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SERVED.  (4) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY TO THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL MULTIPLE EVENT CLASS C LICENSE WHO HAS AN APPROVED LICENSED PREMISES.

6 7 8	3. THE RECORDS SHALL INCLUDE A COMPLETED PRE-AND POST-INVENTORY OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL EVENT.
9 10	(IV) A LICENSE HOLDER WHO VIOLATES THIS PARAGRAPH IS SUBJECT TO:
11	1. FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE OF \$100; AND
12 13 14	2. FOR THE SECOND OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 AND DENIAL OF FUTURE REQUESTS FOR A LICENSE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL EVENT OR A SPECIAL MULTIPLE EVENT LICENSE.
15 16 17	(IV) AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL OF THE COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE AND THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY INSPECT THE PREMISES OF A LICENSE HOLDER AS PROVIDED UNDER § 16–405 OF THIS ARTICLE.
