2 **Public Institutions of Higher Education – Student Withdrawal Policy –**
3 **Reimbursement of Tuition and Fees**
4 **(Cameron Carden Act of 2024)**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring each public institution of higher education to adopt a policy
6 to authorize a student to withdraw under extenuating circumstances and ~~reimburse~~
7 refund the student for tuition and fees paid by the student for a certain semester
8 under certain circumstances; and generally relating to withdrawal policies at public
9 institutions of higher education.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 **15–138.**

19 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES” INCLUDES:**

- 3 **(3) HOSPITALIZATION; AND**
- 4 **(4) MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS.**

5 **(B) (1) EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ADOPT**
 6 **A POLICY THAT AUTHORIZES A STUDENT TO WITHDRAW FOR EXTENUATING**
 7 **CIRCUMSTANCES.**

8 **(2) THE POLICY UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL**
 9 **INCLUDE A PROVISION TO ~~REIMBURSE~~ REFUND A STUDENT FOR TUITION AND FEES**
 10 **PAID BY THE STUDENT FOR THE SEMESTER IN WHICH THE STUDENT WITHDRAWS IF**
 11 **THE EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES INHIBIT THE STUDENT’S ABILITY TO ACQUIRE**
 12 **AN EDUCATION AT THE PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, AS DEFINED**
 13 **IN POLICY.**

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 15 1, 2024.
