12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 17	(p) (1) (i) "Snare trap" means a device made of wire, synthetic cord, or other material that:
18 19	1. Is in the form of a noose with a slipknot, stop, swivel, or eyelet holes; and
20 21	2. Is designed or set with the intent of capturing an animal by the neck.
22	(ii) "Snare trap" includes:

1	1. A pole snare;
2	2. A hanging snare; and
3	3. A neck snare.
4 5 6	(2) [(i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, in] IN Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, [Cecil,] Harford, Montgomery, and Prince George's counties, a person may not use, sell, [possess,] set, place, or maintain a snare trap.
7 8	[(ii) In Anne Arundel County, from July 1, 1990 through June 30, 1992, a person may sell or possess a snare trap.]
9 10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021 .
