3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class MT (movie theater) beer, wine, and liquor license in Anne Arundel County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Anne 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Arundel County to issue the license to the owner of a movie theater; authorizing a 6 license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor to certain patrons at retail at the place 7 described in the license for on-premises consumption; specifying the hours during 8 which the license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor; specifying where and how 9 on the licensed premises beer, wine, and liquor may be sold; stating that a license holder need not obtain a certain Sunday license: establishing an annual license fee; 1011 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel County.
