SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(a) In an order passed under this subtitle, the court may include a provision,
directed to any party, regarding:

- 17 (1) custody of the child;
- 18 (2) visitation privileges with the child;
