A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Correctional Facilities – Full-Body Scanners**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional
4 Services to deploy and use full-body scanners at certain correctional facilities;
5 requiring the Department to make a certain report to the General Assembly on
6 or before a certain date; and generally relating to correctional facilities.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
8 MARYLAND, That:

9 (a) The Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services shall deploy
10 and use at least one full-body scanner at each correctional facility within the
11 jurisdiction of the Department as discussed in the final report of the Special Joint
12 Commission on Public Safety and Security in State and Local Correctional Facilities.

13 (b) The Department shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance
14 with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the results of the deployment on or
15 before December 31, 2014.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 June 1, 2014.
