BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 **Article - Education** 14 4-138. 15 16 BEGINNING IN THE 2021–2022 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL 17 REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY TO PROVIDE 18 HANDWRITING INSTRUCTION THAT ENABLES STUDENTS TO DEVELOP:

19 (1) LEGIBLE PRINT HANDWRITING BY THE END OF THE THIRD GRADE;

20 AND

21 (2) LEGIBLE CURSIVE HANDWRITING BY THE END OF THE FIFTH

22 GRADE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2  $\,$  1, 2020.
