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Dental Hygienist – Scope of Practice – Authority to Practice Under General Supervision of Licensed Dentist

- 4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain provision of law to provide that a general license to 5 practice dental hygiene authorizes the licensee to practice dental hygiene under the 6 general supervision of a licensed dentist in certain facilities, rather than only in a 7 long-term care facility; altering the requirements that a dental hygienist is required 8 to meet before being authorized to practice dental hygiene under the general 9 supervision of a licensed dentist in certain facilities; altering the requirements that must be met by a dental hygienist who is practicing under the general supervision 10 11 of a licensed dentist in certain facilities and performing a certain dental hygiene 12 service; making conforming changes; defining a certain term; repealing a certain 13 definition; and generally relating to the authority of dental hygienists to practice under the general supervision of licensed dentists. 14
