Vehicle Registration - Special Plates for Honorably Discharged Veterans

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to develop and issue special 4 registration plates for honorably discharged veterans of all branches of the armed forces of the United States; specifying who may apply and the classes of vehicles 5 6 eligible for the special registration plates; establishing the manner in which certain 7 fees will be established, retained, and credited in connection with the special 8 registration plates; specifying the contents of the special registration plates; 9 requiring the Administration to adopt certain regulations; altering the composition 10 of the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund; and generally relating to the issuance of special registration plates for honorably discharged veterans of all branches of the 11 armed forces of the United States. 12

- 1 THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE, A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE UNDER A 2 LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, OR A DIRECTOR, AN OFFICER, AN EMPLOYEE, 3 OR A PARTNER OF A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT OWNS THE VEHICLE CONSIDERED 4 ELIGIBLE BY THE ADMINISTRATION MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR THE 5 ASSIGNMENT OF A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE 6 VEHICLE IS INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES: 7 (I)A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE; 8 (II) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S 9 RATED CAPACITY OF 1 TON OR LESS; (III) A CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLE; OR 10 11 (IV) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE. 12 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER 13 THIS SUBSECTION, AN APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE PROOF THAT IS SATISFACTORY TO THE ADMINISTRATION THAT THE APPLICANT IS AN HONORABLY DISCHARGED 14 VETERAN OF A BRANCH OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES. 15 16 (B) **(1)** IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE 17 REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, AN OWNER OF A VEHICLE ASSIGNED A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY: 18 19 **(I)** AN ADDITIONAL INITIAL REGISTRATION FEE SET BY THE 20 ADMINISTRATION WHEN THE NEW REGISTRATION PLATES ARE ISSUED TO THE 21VEHICLE UNDER THIS SECTION; OR 22 (II)AN ADDITIONAL RENEWAL FEE SET \mathbf{BY} THE 23ADMINISTRATION EACH TIME THE PLATE IS RENEWED. 24**(2)** THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL SET THE ADDITIONAL INITIAL (I)25REGISTRATION FEE AT A LEVEL THAT: 26 WILL ENABLE THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER 1. - 6 BE RETAINED BY OR TRANSFERRED TO ANY AGENCY OF THE STATE FOR ANY

- 8 (IV) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS
- 9 PARAGRAPH, THE SURPLUS MONEY AND MONEY COLLECTED FOR ADDITIONAL

- 19 (D) A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION:
- 20 (1) MAY CONSIST OF ANY COMBINATION OF LETTERS, NUMERALS, OR
- 21 BOTH; AND
- 22 (2) SHALL INCLUDE WORDS OR AN EMBLEM OR LOGO INDICATING
- 23 THAT THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE HOLDER IS AN HONORABLY DISCHARGED
- 24 VETERAN OF A BRANCH OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 25 (E) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NOT
- 26 INCONSISTENT WITH THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW TO GOVERN THE ISSUANCE OF
- 27 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.
