Office of Legislative Audits – Performance Audits of Boards of License Commissioners – Required

FOR the purpose of requiring the Office of Legislative Audits, at least once every certain

Baltimore City; altering the frequency with which the Office is required to audit the
Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City; and generally relating to
performance audits conducted by the Office of Legislative Audits.

19 (f) (1) At least once every [4] 6 years, the Office of Legislative Audits shall 20 conduct a performance audit of the Board of [Liquor] License Commissioners [for Baltimore 21 City] FOR EACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS to evaluate the effectiveness 22 and efficiency of the management practices of [the Board] EACH BOARD and of the 23 economy with which [the Board] EACH BOARD uses resources.

1 (2) The performance audit shall focus on operations relating to liquor 2 inspections, licensing, disciplinary procedures, and management oversight.
