A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

State Board of Dental Examiners – Appointment of Members

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain balloting and nomination process to select the names of certain candidates to submit to the Governor to be members of the State 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Board of Dental Examiners; requiring the Board, within a certain period of time, to 6 notify certain practicing licensees and professional organizations of a vacancy on the 7 Board, provide certain information, solicit certain nominations for the vacancy, and 8 forward certain nominations and petitions to the Governor; authorizing the Governor 9 to fill a vacancy on the Board in a certain manner; making conforming changes; and generally relating to the appointment of members of the State Board of Dental 1011 Examiners.
