### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Allegany County – Alcoholic Beverages – Arts and Entertainment District License

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Class C (on-sale) beer and wine Arts and  $\mathbf{5}$ Entertainment District license in Allegany County; authorizing the Board of License 6 Commissioners to issue the license to a for-profit festival promoter; establishing that 7 the license authorizes the holder to exercise the privileges of the license at an 8 entertainment event that is held in an arts and entertainment district in the county; 9 establishing certain privileges for the license related to the purchase, transport, and consumption of beer and wine within the approved event area; requiring an applicant 1011 for a license to submit an application under oath on the form that the Board provides; 12establishing that certain provisions of law governing the application for, and 13 issuance and denial of, alcoholic beverages licenses in the county do not apply to the 14license; requiring the license holder to distribute a wristband to certain individuals 15at the entertainment event; prohibiting the license holder from serving beer or wine 16to an individual who does not wear a wristband; establishing certain penalties for 17certain violations of this Act; authorizing a license holder to hold another alcoholic 18 beverages license of a different class or nature: establishing a certain maximum 19duration for the license; limiting the number of licenses that may be issued to an 20individual festival promoter in a calendar year; establishing a certain license fee; 21and generally relating to the Class C beer and wine Arts and Entertainment District 22license in Allegany County.

(III) CONSUME THE BEER OR WINE WITHIN THE APPROVED
EVENT AREA, INCLUDING THE PREMISES OF ANY LICENSE HOLDER WITH ON-SALE
PRIVILEGES.

7 (D) (1) AN APPLICANT FOR THE LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION 8 UNDER OATH ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES.

9 (2) SUBTITLES 14 AND 15 OF THIS TITLE DO NOT APPLY TO AN 10 APPLICANT FOR THE LICENSE.

11 (E) (1) THE LICENSE HOLDER:

12 (I) AT THE ENTERTAINMENT EVENT FOR WHICH THE LICENSE
13 IS ISSUED SHALL DISTRIBUTE A WRISTBAND TO EACH INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AT LEAST
14 21 YEARS OLD; AND

15(II) MAY NOT SERVE BEER OR WINE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO16DOES NOT WEAR A WRISTBAND.

- 17 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBSECTION IS SUBJECT TO:
- 18

(I) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE OF \$250; AND

19 (II) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 20 AND DENIAL OF FURTHER APPLICATIONS FOR A CLASS C (ON–SALE) BEER AND WINE 21 ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT LICENSE.

22 (F) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY HOLD ANOTHER LICENSE OF A DIFFERENT 23 CLASS OR NATURE.

- 24 (G) THE LICENSE:
- 25 (1) MAY BE USED FOR A MAXIMUM OF 3 CONSECUTIVE DAYS; AND

26 (2) MAY NOT BE ISSUED TO AN INDIVIDUAL FOR-PROFIT FESTIVAL 27 PROMOTER MORE THAN ONCE IN A CALENDAR YEAR.

28 (H) THE LICENSE FEE IS \$500 PER DAY.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 1, 2019.
