## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## Frederick County Board of Education – Student Member

3 FOR the purpose of altering the duties, rights, and privileges of the student member of the 4 Frederick County Board of Education; altering the group of students who elect the  $\mathbf{5}$ student member; requiring the student member to serve as the student 6 member-elect and shadow a certain member for a certain time period; requiring the 7 student member to comply with certain ethics and financial disclosure requirements 8 and vote on certain matters; authorizing the student member to attend an executive 9 session of the county board that relates to certain matters; prohibiting the student member from participating when the county board is carrying out a quasi-judicial 1011 function; authorizing the nonstudent members of the county board, on a majority 12vote, to determine in a certain manner whether a matter under consideration is 13 covered by certain exclusionary provisions and to rescind certain voting rights of the 14 student member under certain circumstances; providing that the student member 15may not be counted in a certain quorum determination; providing for the resolution 16of a certain tie vote; making conforming changes; and generally relating to the 17student member of the Frederick County Board of Education.

25 26 27	(a) The president of the Frederick County Board is entitled to receive \$11,000 annually as compensation, and each other [voting] NONSTUDENT member of the Frederick County Board is entitled to receive \$10,000 annually as compensation.
$\frac{28}{29}$	(b) The president and all other <b>NONSTUDENT</b> members of the Frederick County Board are entitled to health insurance benefits regularly provided to employees of the

30 Frederick County public school system.

2 (a) All actions of the county board shall be taken at a public meeting and a record 3 of the meeting and all actions shall be made public.

4 (b) The county board may take actions in closed session in accordance with § 5 3–305 of the General Provisions Article.

6 (C) THE STUDENT MEMBER MAY NOT BE COUNTED IN DETERMINING 7 WHETHER THE NUMBER OF BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT AT A MEETING CONSTITUTES 8 A QUORUM OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

9 (D) IF THE STUDENT MEMBER'S VOTE RESULTS IN A TIE VOTE AMONG THE 10 BOARD MEMBERS, THE MATTER SHALL BE DECIDED WITHOUT COUNTING THE 11 STUDENT MEMBER'S VOTE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 1, 2020.
