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Health – Psychiatric Hospitals – Units Licensed as Limited Private Inpatient Facilities

- FOR the purpose of requiring certain hospitals that provide certain care in a unit that is licensed as a limited private inpatient facility to authorize patients to seek insurance reimbursement for certain services, bill certain patients in a certain manner, and provide certain staff assistance; requiring the Office of Health Care Quality, on or before a certain date, to make a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly; and generally relating to units within psychiatric hospitals that are licensed as limited private inpatient facilities.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Health General
- 19 **19–1813.**
- A STATE OR PRIVATE PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITAL THAT PROVIDES SUBACUTE CARE TO PATIENTS IN A UNIT WITHIN THE HOSPITAL THAT IS LICENSED AS A
- 22 LIMITED PRIVATE INPATIENT FACILITY SHALL:
- 23 (1) AUTHORIZE PATIENTS IN THE UNIT TO SEEK INSURANCE 24 REIMBURSEMENT FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE UNIT;



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- 1 (2) BILL PATIENTS RECEIVING SERVICES IN THE UNIT IN A MANNER 2 THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH BILLING STANDARDS REQUIRED BY INSURANCE 3 CARRIERS; AND
 - (3) PROVIDE STAFF ASSISTANCE TO PATIENTS SEEKING INSURANCE REIMBURSEMENT FOR SERVICES PROVIDED IN THE UNIT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31, 2019, the Office of Health Care Quality shall report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on:
- 10 (1) the units providing behavioral health services and operating within psychiatric hospitals that are licensed as limited private inpatient facilities;
- 12 (2) whether the licensure of each unit as a limited private inpatient facility 13 is appropriate;
- 14 (3) the number of patients in units providing behavioral health services 15 and operating within psychiatric hospitals that are licensed as limited private inpatient 16 facilities who have had all or part of their bills for treatment paid through insurance; and
- 17 (4) the percentage of gross revenues of a unit providing behavioral health 18 services and operating within a psychiatric hospital that is licensed as a limited private 19 inpatient facility that are paid by the patient, through insurance, or by other entities.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
