A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Correctional Services – Inmate Release (Suzanne Jones Act)

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Division of Correction to transport a certain inmate from
5 a certain correctional facility to a certain jurisdiction at a certain time; requiring the
6 Division of Parole and Probation to supervise any required probation, parole, or
7 mandatory supervision of a certain inmate in a certain jurisdiction at a certain time;
8 and generally relating to the release of inmates.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Correctional Services

17 **9–609.2.**

18 **AFTER AN INMATE IS RELEASED FROM CONFINEMENT IN A STATE**
19 **CORRECTIONAL FACILITY:**

20 **(1) THE DIVISION SHALL TRANSPORT THE INMATE FROM THE**
21 **CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TO THE JURISDICTION WHERE THE INMATE WAS**
22 **DOMICILED IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE INMATE’S CONFINEMENT; AND**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(2) THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION SHALL SUPERVISE**
2 **ANY REQUIRED PROBATION, PAROLE, OR MANDATORY SUPERVISION OF THE INMATE**
3 **IN THE JURISDICTION WHERE THE INMATE WAS DOMICILED IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO**
4 **THE INMATE'S CONFINEMENT.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2019.
