3 FOR the purpose of altering the formula under which the Vehicle Theft Prevention Council
4 allocates grants from the Vehicle Theft Prevention Fund; and generally relating to
5 the Vehicle Theft Prevention Fund.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Public Safety**

19 2–101.

1 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

2 (e) "Department" means the Department of State Police.

3 2-702.

4 (a) (1) There is a Vehicle Theft Prevention Council in the Department.

5 (2) The purpose of the Council is to help prevent and deter theft of private
6 passenger and commercial motor vehicles and related crime, including vandalism and theft
7 of property from vehicles, in the State.

8 2-703.

9 (a) There is a Vehicle Theft Prevention Fund.

10 (g) To the extent practicable, the Council ~~shall allocate~~ **SHALL CONSIDER**
11 **ALLOCATING** grants made under this subtitle among the subdivisions of the State on a pro
12 rata basis determined by ~~the total number of vehicles registered~~ **STOLEN** in each
13 subdivision divided by the total number of vehicles ~~registered~~ **STOLEN** in the State; ~~THE~~
14 ~~NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLE THEFTS IN A SUBDIVISION DIVIDED BY THE TOTAL~~
15 ~~POPULATION OF THAT SUBDIVISION AND THEN MULTIPLIED BY 100,000.~~

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2022.
