SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 Article Tax Property
- 20 2-203.

(a) (1) The Department shall continually review all real property assessments
 to provide a review of each assessment at least once in each 3-year cycle.

(2) If any assessment has not been reviewed during a 3-year cycle, the
 Department may order a review of the assessment at any time.

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1 (c) On request of the property tax assessment appeal board for the county in 2 which the property is located, the Director shall order a review of any real property 3 assessment.

(d) When reviewing real property under this section, the Department [may]
SHALL use property description cards, property location maps, land classification maps,
unit value maps, land use maps, zoning maps, records of new construction, sales records,
building cost information, private appraisals, periodic surveys of assessment ratios, [or]
AND any other material or information that the Department considers to be a reliable aid
in determining real property value.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 11 1, 2020.
