## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Wicomico County – Alcoholic Beverages – Bed and Breakfast License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B–BB (bed and breakfast) beer and wine license 4 in Wicomico County; providing the qualifications that must be met for issuance of  $\mathbf{5}$ the license; authorizing the license holder to sell alcoholic beverages to guests of the 6 establishment under certain circumstances; authorizing the license holder to sell 7 alcoholic beverages to guests of certain catered events under certain circumstances; 8 authorizing the license holder to allow certain guests to consume personal alcoholic 9 beverages on the premises under certain circumstances and subject to a certain 10 limitation; specifying the hours of sale of alcoholic beverages; specifying that, except 11 during certain catered events or ticketed events hosted by the license holder, the 12license does not authorize the license holder to sell alcoholic beverages to certain 13 individuals; specifying that a license is void under certain circumstances and must 14 be returned to the Board of License Commissioners for Wicomico County; specifying 15that certain restrictions do not apply to a permanent resident of the establishment 16or to guests of the permanent resident; requiring the license holder to retain and 17make available certain records; setting an annual fee for the license; and generally 18 relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Wicomico County.

13	(2) The license authorizes the license holder to allow a
13 14	GUEST OF THE BED AND BREAKFAST, WHOSE NAME AND ADDRESS APPEAR ON THE
15	REGISTRY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT, TO BRING PERSONAL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
16	ONTO THE PREMISES FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION DURING THE HOURS AND
17	DAYS AS SET OUT UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION.
18	(E) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER AND WINE FOR ON-PREMISES
19	CONSUMPTION ON MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY, FROM 7 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT.
20	(F) EXCEPT DURING CATERED EVENTS THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS
21	UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION OR TICKETED EVENTS HOSTED BY THE
22	LICENSE HOLDER, THE LICENSE DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF BEER AND WINE
23	TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
24	(1) IS NOT A GUEST OF THE BED AND BREAKFAST; OR
25	(2) IS REGISTERED AS A GUEST AT THE BED AND BREAKFAST ONLY TO

11	(J) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$300.
12 13	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
