- 2 (A) THERE IS A CLASS C (VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR VOLUNTEER 3 AMBULANCE COMPANY) LICENSE.
- 4 (B) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES A VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR 5 VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE COMPANY TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ONLY 6 DURING A FUND-RAISING EVENT FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.
- 7 (C) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PROVIDE THE BOARD WITH NOTICE OF A 8 FUND-RAISING EVENT AT LEAST 14 DAYS BEFORE THE EVENT IS TO BE HELD.
- 9 (D) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$500.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
