Regional Initiative to Limit or Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions in

(Regional Transportation and Climate Protection Act of 2019)

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Governor to include the State as a full participant in a 6 certain initiative, agreement, or compact that limits or reduces greenhouse gas 7 emissions from the transportation sector; authorizing the Governor to impose a 8 certain statewide greenhouse gas emission fee on the sale or distribution of motor 9 fuel under certain circumstances; requiring the Department of the Environment and 10 the Department of Transportation to report to certain committees of the General 11 Assembly on or before a certain date, and with a certain frequency thereafter, on the 12 status of a certain initiative, agreement, or compact that limits or reduces 13 greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector; requiring the General 14 Assembly to enact a law approving the withdrawal of the State from a certain 15 initiative, agreement, or compact that limits or reduces greenhouse gas emissions 16 from the transportation sector; and generally relating to limiting or reducing 17 greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector.

- THE STATE MAY WITHDRAW FROM A REGIONAL GOVERNMENTAL 31
- 32 INITIATIVE, AGREEMENT, OR COMPACT ENTERED INTO UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE
- GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENACTS A LAW TO APPROVE THE WITHDRAWAL. 33
